

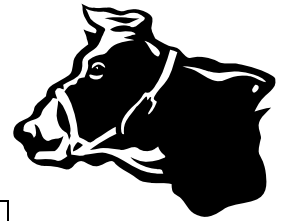

MONTH 1:

Income	Expenses

Your friend is having problems with his computer. You agree to fix it for him at \$56 an hour. You work 3.5 hours.

Income	Expenses

You decide to open a coffee shop with 3 of your friends for one month only to earn extra income. The 4 of you decide to split all expenses and profits equally.
 Expenses: Rent, \$300 Supplies, \$260 Misc. Expenses, \$80
 Income: \$4,600



MONTH 1:

Income	Expenses

You get a job at the local research institute working with mice. You get \$7 an hour and 10% of the grant money allotted for each project.

Project 1: Vitamin Deficiencies, 3 hours, \$5,000 grant allotment
 Antibiotic Effects, 4 hours, \$2,000 grant allotment
 Adverse Behavior, 7 hours, \$3,000



MONTH 2:

Income	Expenses

You and 2 friends decide to make pillows for the annual Craft Fair. You will split all expenses and profits 3 ways.

Expenses: Booth Rental, \$50 Material & Thread, \$105
 Pillow Stuffing, \$75 Decorations, \$210
 Income: \$175

Income	Expenses

Your best friend is getting married. The wedding is this month, but it is in New Mexico. You've been friends for a long time and need to go.

Your expenses: Airline ticket, \$364
 Rental car, \$32
 Wedding Gift, \$29



MONTH 2:

Income	Expenses

You agree to keep your neighbor's bird while she is out of town. You decide to let the bird fly around and intimidate your cat. However, the bird flies up to the ceiling fan, which you forgot to turn off and this knocks poor Polly into a frenzy. You rush the bird to the vet and he charges \$79. You take Polly home and notice that the stitches on her head are very visible. You don't want your neighbor to get mad, so you decide to buy her another bird. You find one like Polly at the pet store and pay \$178. You decide to run an ad in the paper to sell Polly because the cat doesn't like her. The ad expense is \$8. Only one person calls and you sell Polly for \$36.



MONTH 2:

Income	Expenses

You decide to enter a fishing contest and win 1st place. The prize is \$500. You also have the following expenses:

- Entry Fee, \$25
- Boat Rental, \$65
- Fishing License, \$75



MONTH 3:

Income	Expenses

Your friends are going to the beach for the weekend and want you to come along. You don't want to miss out on the fun, so you tell them you'll go. You will pay 1/4th of the following expenses:

- Hotel, \$325
- Gas, \$78
- Groceries, \$128



MONTH 3:

Income	Expenses

You are sick and must go to the emergency room. Your expenses are:

- Hospital, \$650
- Doctor, \$290
- Medication, \$67



If you have insurance, you only have to pay 20% of the total bill. If you do not have insurance, you will owe the whole amount.

MONTH 3:

Income	Expenses

While trying to answer your cell phone, you run into the back of another car.

- Expenses:
- Repair to your car, \$800
 - Towing Charge, \$65
 - Repair to the other person's car, \$300
 - Ticket, \$125



If you have auto insurance, you will only be responsible for the ticket and 10% of the other expenses.

MONTH 3:

Income	Expenses

You decide to have a BBQ for all your friends. You invite 35 people and all but 2 show up. It cost you \$7.50 per person.



MONTH 4:

Income	Expenses

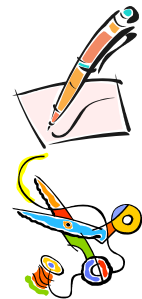
You take a trip to Colorado with your friend. You see a bear and shoot it. The Park Ranger fines you \$75 for hunting without a license and \$150 for shooting an animal off of a game reserve. You take the case to small claims court. The court fee is \$60 and the attorney's fee is \$50 an hour. You are in court for 1 ½ hours. The judge rules that you must pay the two fines. Your friend feels sorry for you and buys the bear from you for \$250 to make a rug.



MONTH 4:

Income	Expenses

You are at the convenience store when Faith Hill pulls in to get gas. You ask for her autograph and she signs your gas receipt. The store clerk is a huge fan of hers and offers you \$250. You can sell it or keep it. However, when you leave the gas station, you back into one of the pumps. This causes \$450 worth of damage. If you have auto insurance, they will cover all but 10%. If you don't have insurance, you will be responsible for the whole amount.

It's your parents' 20th wedding anniversary and you decide to throw them a party. The costs:

- Cake and Ice Cream, \$32.89
- Decorations, \$17.92
- Invitations & Postage, \$17.16
- Gift, \$25
- Paper Goods, \$26.14
- Beverages, \$11.55



MONTH 4:

Income	Expenses

The science department at the local university has lost a rare collection of harlequin beetles. The university is offering a reward. The female beetles are worth \$18.50, and the male beetles are worth \$17.50. You find 12 females and 9 males.



MONTH 5:

Income	Expenses

You have a garden and want to set up a fruit and vegetable stand in the grocery store parking lot. You sell the following fruits and vegetables:



- 56 tomatoes @ 25 cents each
- 42 bell peppers @ 17 cents each
- 34 ears of corn @ 35 cents each
- 12 Watermelons @\$2 each

MONTH 5:

Income	Expenses

You get a night job waiting tables at the country club for one week to help out with the grand opening. You earn 10% of the total food bill plus \$4 an hour.



- Monday: 3 hours, \$250 food bill
- Tuesday: 2 hours, \$100 food bill
- Wednesday: 4 hours, \$150 food bill
- Thursday: 2 hours, \$210 food bill
- Friday: 4 hours, \$450 food bill

MONTH 5:

Income	Expenses

A terrible storm blew part of your roof off and the rain flooded your living room. The landlord will fix the roof, but you need to replace your furniture. Expense: \$1250. If you had content insurance, they will pay 90%. There is no deductible.
